Research at the Townsville HHS

Research is the keystone to evidence-based health care to improve patient outcomes and experiences. Access to new and improved treatment options Townsville HHS (Hospital and Health Service), have enhanced patient outcomes and put patients at the core of what we do. Building upon our experiences in North Queensland providing tertiary and quaternary care with our partners at Torres and Cape, Cairns and Hinterland, North West and Mackay HHS's provides an insight to recognize and leverage the unique challenges and opportunities of our region.

The Townsville HHS has grown its research funding by \$7.9 million over the last 5 years, with a 94% increase of publications. We are positioning ourselves through collaborations with academic partners, research organisations, health care providers and educational institutions including the Tropical Australian Academic Health Centre (TAAHC) to be amongst the leading research institutes in northern Australia.

The Townsville Institute of Health Research and Innovation (THIRI) is entering a phase of growth and is facing a unique operating environment in which we can leverage the available opportunities, while effectively managing the challenges present on our region. This strategic plan is intended to guide us to engage with meaningful collaborations and impactful research for these next 4 years.

Our strategic priorities

Digital health research - developing a digitally enabled research environment to improve research effectiveness.

First Nations people - Increasing the participation of First Nations people in all aspects of our research.

Collaboration - building upon collaborations with colleagues. Interdepartmental, external academic partners, TAAHC and with other HHSs.

Innovation and translation - Leveraging new research opportunities to deliver better outcomes and experiences.

Workforce and staff - Providing opportunities including Queensland Training for Research Active Clinicians (QTRAC) for researchers to enhance their skills and follow their curiosity.



Our challenges

- Ongoing demand for service delivery detracts from allocated research time
- Responding to the immediate and long-term impact of the COVID-19 pandemic
- There is a high prevalence of chronic diseases within our community
- Attracting and retaining a diverse work force with specialist skills in regional Queensland
- · Limited funding potential due to constrained funding environment
- System fragmentation affecting the ability to supply integrated services
- · Limited research methods expertise.

- Integration of digital health into our research activities for more efficient improvements in better value health care
- Uniquely located as the only tertiary university hospital in northern Queensland
- Being a major employer in the region generating a positive influence on the local economic environment
- Curiosity driven clinical research culture supports the attainment of clinical excellence
- Development of new and strengthening current collaborations between inter-disciplinary colleagues within Townsville HHS, with other HHSs, within TAAHC and with external academic partners

- Encourage innovation through a staged funding program
