Our Performance

We are consistently, and proudly, one of the top performing health services in Queensland. Like health services globally, however, we face an increasingly challenging operating environment.

In 2025-2026, we will focus on the following performance goals:

- Improving emergency access and patient flow
- Decreasing the number of maintenance patients in hospital
- Reducing long waits for elective surgery and outpatient care
- Improving health equity for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Increasing virtual care utilisation and providing more care closer to home
- Delivering major infrastructure expansions on time and within budget
- Optimising our efficiency and ensuring financial sustainability
- Ensuring the safety, wellbeing, and engagement of our staff.

Our Services

We provide the full continuum of healthcare, including primary and community care, oral health services, birthing, emergency services, subspecialty medicine and surgery, and residential aged care.

Each day, across our 21 facilities:

- 140,000 emergency presentations
- 500,000 outpatient appointments
- 20,000 surgical and other procedures
- 110,000 hospital admissions.

This is achieved through a workforce of more than 7,500 people who come to work to support or directly provide these vital services.
