How to use the **Virtual Clinic**

What is the Virtual Clinic?

Virtual Clinic provides patients with a **video** link for them to complete their health care appointments online.

The connection is **safe** and **secure**. This means uninvited people cannot access the session at the same time.

You will be sent a link to your **email** or **phone**.

Please use a device that has a working **camera** and **microphone**. This can be a mobile phone, computer, Ipad or tablet.

The larger the screen, the better, and having a **stable internet** connection works best.

A step-by-step process is outlined on the next pages explaining how to connect to your online appointment using your device.

You will receive an email from Queensland Health like below.





It will ask permission to use your camera and microphone. Click allow.





You will be taken to a screen that looks like this.

You will be able to see your face.

This is the waiting room.




The clinician will then connect, and you will be able to see their face as well instead of the waiting room.



Text message


You will receive a text message that looks like this.
Click the link.



You will be taken to a screen that looks like this.
You will be able to see your face.
This is the waiting room.



The therapist will then connect and you will be able to see their face as well instead of the holding screen.



If the connection is not working:

If you see a blank screen, restart the computer/phone/ipad or device you are using.
