

## Acute Care Team Community Pathway

You recently presented at our Emergency Department (ED) at the Townsville University Hospital (TUH).

## You've been discharged, what now?

- Your follow up care will be with our Acute Care Team (ACT). This is our mental health crisis team.
- A referral with your details has been sent to ACT so they should be in touch with you within 72 hours to arrange an appointment.
- You may wish to connect with your General Practitioner (GP). They can give you extra support and provide you with treatment you may need.
- ACT can be contacted for crisis assistance and support on

## General advice

- We recommend you do not use any alcohol or drugs at this time. Using substances can be very harmful to your mental health and well-being, especially when you are not feeling well
- If substance use is a problem for you, you may want to contact our Alcohol, Tobacco and Other Drugs Service (ATODS) on 4433 9600 to take those first steps in getting help
- Please remember, if things aren't getting better, or are starting to get worse, return to the ED for further care
- If you have immediate concerns about the safety of you or your loved one, contact triple zero (000).
